Chairman Norm Weaver called the Monday March 20, 2017 meeting of the Hughes County Board of Commissioners to order at 5:30 PM with members Roger Inman, Bill M. Abernathy, Jim Hardwick and Tom Tveit present. Director of Equalization Melissa Flottmeyer and Sheriff Mike Leidholt were also present. The meeting began with prayer by Pastor John Fette and the Pledge of Allegiance.

**AGENDA:** Moved by Abernathy and seconded by Inman to approve the agenda. All voted aye. Motion passed.

**MINUTES:** Moved by Abernathy and seconded by Hardwick to approve the minutes of the March 6, 2017 Commission meeting. All voted aye. Motion passed.

**SPECIAL BUSINESS:** Hughes County was recognized with a plaque from SDML Workers Compensation Fund for 30 years of membership.

BERGESON FLOOD DEVELOPMENT PERMIT: Scott Schweitzer with Brosz Engineering, Don Bergeson and Layne Bergeson appeared requesting to build an access road from Dry Run Road across Dry Run Creek to access Austin Bergeson® property. John Childs and Sharon Pruess were also present representing the City of Pierre. The Commission discussed their concerns with the crossing with Bergesons, to include access to the property during flooding, the possibility the crossing may wash out and make the property inaccessible for a longer period of time, maintenance of the crossing, difficulty for emergency responders to access the property during flooding, the steep slopes on the access road and the slope at the intersection with the County road. The Bergeson® indicated they were aware of those issues and accept them as a consequence of their property location. Moved by Tveit and seconded by Abernathy to accept the design of the low water crossing and record in the Register of Deeds office a document for the property owner to accept responsibility for the crossing, including maintenance. All voted aye. Commissioner Inman recused himself from the vote. The project still needs a Department of the Army 404 permit and final approval of a flood plain development permit. In addition, the property owner will likely need soils tests, septic drain field tests, and a separate flood development permit before a building permit can be issued for the proposed home.
