

## North Bend Wind Project

According to the ordinance in the letter referencing to this meeting it states that a large wind energy conversion system will not disrupt the appropriate use of land and resources.

Some of the resources would be soil, water, sunlight and also wind. For example corn uses soil, water, sunlight and is used for fuel, feed, and energy. Wind is another source of energy that God gave us to use.

The ordinance also states that it will not hinder the use of nearby properties.

Under South Dakota Game Fish & Parks guidelines no one shall hunt within 660 ft of a house, school, church or livestock.

If these fewer locations were houses that would mean that Bollweg's could hunt all of their preserve land and their land consisting of SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec 11, NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec 10 and 80 acres in sec 16 all in 111-74 that is not in the preserve.

Under the PUC website on 2-7-2022 Jon Tharber from PUC stated that in the Denel Harvest Wind Farm Project the closest turbine from South Dakota Pheasant Hunt Preserve was 633 ft. He also stated that closest tower to Tumbleweed Lodge Preserve will be 3467 ft. therefore no towers will be close to their preserve. And only a few will be near their properties not in the preserve as stated above.
